Performance Recommendations


- In general, err on the side of a slightly slower tempo rather than a faster one. That said, do adhere to a fairly strict pulse and play rhythms as notated.
- Listen mindfully and enjoy the blurring and blending of tones. Follow pedal markings as closely as possible, but use your judgement as it relates to the resonance of the space and the instrument.
